However, the main concern for next season is that HSV have already cancelled 9 of our 43 bookings for the 22-23 season. This means that we have already asked Queenswood school to book us at their facility for these sessions.

3 Treasurer's Report

In summary, the accounts showed that while the club made a very small 'profit' of approximately £245 on a total expenditure of £12,649.95 this was partly because Badminton England had decided to provide Club Membership fee, £100, and individual fees, £4, free this year owing to covid: this would have cost the club an additional £300 approximately.

Fees for 2022-23

Herts Sports Village, shuttlecock suppliers, and Badminton England have all increased their fees by 10% for the coming season. Therefore a vote was taken to increase our club fee by 10%: the vote was 17 for the change with no votes against. So fees for the new season will increase by 10%.
